



Hiking trip to La Gomera



From Friday, March 6th, 2026, to Tuesday, March 10th, 2026

On this journey, we will explore the most mystical of all the islands: La Gomera. It is shaped by deep-rooted stories and traditions, the isolation of its inhabitants, and the vibrant colors of its landscapes. We will breathe in the mist and listen to the songs of forest birds. Perhaps we will even hear the echoes of the whistles that once formed the islanders' language and remain their most important cultural hallmark. It feels as though time has stood still here. This sense of timelessness and mystery reveals itself only to those fortunate enough to visit the island.



On Friday, March 6th, 2026

Hike to the twin rocks Petra and Pedro



The bus takes us from the south of Gran Canaria to the airport. Once we arrive on La Gomera, another bus will be waiting to take us to Hotel Casa Los Herrera, one of the most elegant accommodations in the north of the island. After checking in and taking a short break, we'll set off on our first hike. Our route takes us into the historic region of Mulagua, the pre-colonial name of what is now the municipality of Hermigua. We are on the northern slopes of La Gomera, where the trail leads us up into the heights—into the silent sea of clouds that breaks against the island's cliffs and steep rock faces. Our starting point is San Pedro Monastery, one of the oldest on the Canary Islands. From here, we ascend to El Chorro, the island's highest waterfall, which plunges 140 meters. The climb first takes us through a thermophilic forest of wild olive trees, palm trees, and dragon trees. Before long, we reach the meadows of the laurel forest, where we'll enjoy a picnic near the Presa de Los Tilos. This idyllic spot lies deep within a green ravine, its steep walls seeming to close in above us. Two imposing rocks—Pedro and Petra—rise like sharp teeth along the path, inviting us to step into the quiet gorge they guard. After the hike, we'll end the day with dinner at a restaurant at the foot of the rocks, reflecting on the mystical landscape we've just explored.

On Saturday, March 7th, 2026

Through the Barranco de Guarimiar – a masterpiece of stone and silence




Our hike begins in the remote hamlet of Imada, one of the most untouched places in southern La Gomera. From the very start, we are greeted by the serene beauty of the highlands, with their carefully tended terraces, palm trees, and blossoming almond and fig trees that frame the village in spring. From here, we follow one of the island's most striking paths: the artfully carved Camino etched into the rock as it winds through the Barranco de Guarimiar. This historic trail snakes along the steep walls of the deeply incised gorge in a spectacular, sweeping line. Breathtaking views open up—sheer cliffs, bizarre rock formations, and the dramatic landscape that make this journey truly unforgettable. The descent through the barranco itself is both a natural and a crafted masterpiece—silent testimony to the architectural skill of generations past. At the bottom, we arrive at the small, secluded village of Guarimiar, nestled at the foot of the gorge. The tour culminates with a magnificent ascent to the Roques del Moro, where we pause one last time to let our gaze roam across the rugged terrain before the waiting minibus takes us back. This is not a circular hike, but a remarkable point-to-point journey—a voyage through time, stone, and silence—that reveals the full depth of La Gomera's diverse and dramatic landscape.



On Sunday, March 8, 2026

Garajonay: Through the Cloud Forest to the Forgotten Reservoir



Our hike begins in the small, enchanting village of Serpa, nestled picturesquely at the edge of the cloud forest. Surrounded by lush vegetation and ancient terraced fields, we enter the Garajonay National Park via newly restored hiking and forest trails—a place where time seems to stand still. The path leads us through a world of mist, moss, and centuries-old trees. The dense laurel forest, a primeval woodland, wraps us in a green silence, broken only by the rustling of leaves and the gentle dripping of moisture carried by the trade winds. Here, one truly feels the living essence of the word “primeval forest”—ancient, mysterious, and imbued with mystical





beauty. Our destination lies hidden deep within the heart of the park: the Mérida reservoir. Like something from another world, it rests quietly and mysteriously, surrounded by dense forest. Pale tree trunks and water-worn dead trees rise from its dark waters, lending the landscape an almost surreal atmosphere. The place feels like a forgotten natural masterpiece—both peaceful and slightly eerie. This tour is a journey through the diverse vegetation zones of La Gomera and offers a profound natural experience for anyone wishing to feel the magic of the cloud forest up close. Before we begin our hike, we will also visit the charming village of Agulo and enjoy a brief guided tour.


On Monday, March 9, 2026

The King's Valley and Sunset at the Fortaleza de Chipude



The spectacular Valle Gran Rey, with its lush greenery, fertile soil, countless palm groves, and charming neighborhoods, has long captivated hikers and free spirits alike. We begin with a leisurely stroll through Valle Gran Rey. In Las Hayas, a romantic mountain village in the central highlands, we enjoy a traditional local

lunch. Our hike begins in Igualero, a small hamlet, and takes us up to the Fortaleza de Chipude. This high plateau, the core of an ancient volcano, is a true highlight for archaeologists thanks to its significant archaeological sites. For the island's indigenous people, this flat-topped mountain was sacred. From its summit, the view stretches as far as El Hierro and La Palma. At 7:00 PM, we are treated to a breathtaking sunset, as the pre-Hispanic god Orhan draws the curtain over the stage called La Gomera. We then retrace our steps back to the endpoint: the village of Igualero.
